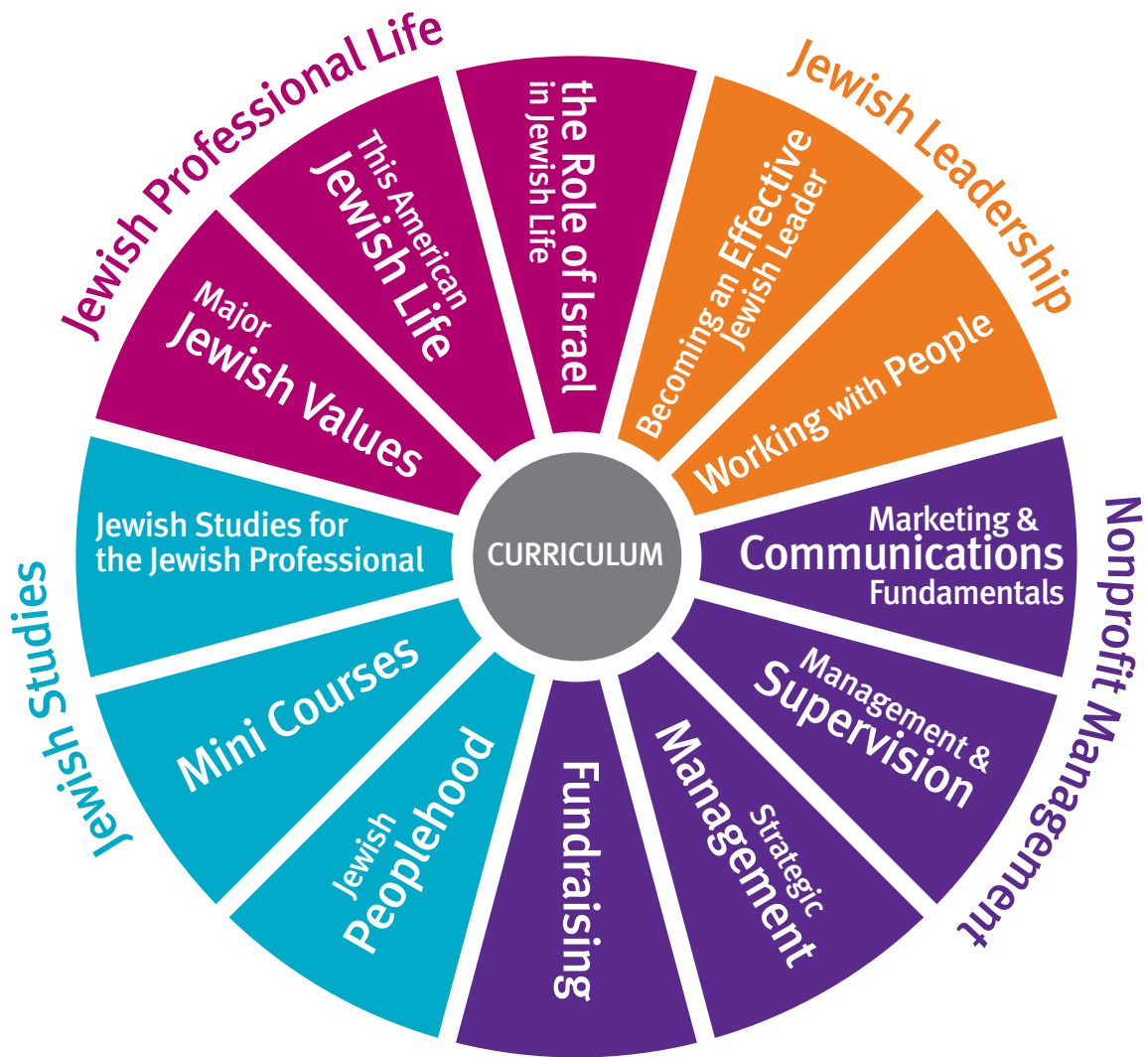

Spertus Institute's **Master of Arts in Jewish Professional Studies (MAJPS)** is a world-class educational opportunity exclusively for professionals working in the Jewish community, and those seeking to transition into careers in the Jewish nonprofit sector.

The MAJPS is offered in small-group cohorts (between 10–18 students) providing a network of fellow professionals with whom to network, learn, and grow. The curriculum emphasizes collaboration using case studies and team exercises.

Courses are taught by effective and creative faculty who understand the importance of bridging theory and practice. Designed for busy professionals, the MAJPS combines weekly classes with seminars, mentoring, and a personalized capstone project. Course work has immediate application.

Program Highlights:

- Non-traditional program geared toward busy, working adults
- Emphasis on learning that is relevant to students' careers
- Distinguished, accessible faculty
- Professional mentoring as a component of the program
- Can be completed in just over two years
- Fellowships cover a significant portion of the tuition

The MAJPS program offers the opportunity to earn an additional certification as part of your integrated coursework (additional fees may apply) in either **Jewish Leadership** (through a partnership between Spertus and Northwestern University) or **Israel Education** (through a partnership between Spertus and the iCenter).
